Allow me to remind you that the MEUHP is a membership organization and your district is a member for the purpose of providing health insurance and other benefits for you. Therefore, as a member-owned organization, we are constantly striving to provide customized benefits that meets the needs of educational employees. This newsletter will cover many of those benefits, some of which you are already aware of and some will be new to you. I hope you will please take a moment and go through all

of the information, and I also hope that you will put the enclosed magnet on your refrigerator so that you have easy access to the information that you need to get the most out of your health insurance program through the MEUHP.

Of course, the thing that is first and foremost on many minds is the COVID-19 situation and where we are headed. I have personally used the testing and found it to be quite easy and efficient. While it is free to our membership and is completed at home, you still must meet the requirements to be tested. The last thing that I want to mention is our new MEUHP Cost Saver Program. Since its inception on July 1, 2020, it has become very popular. By allowing the MEUHP Cost Saver Program to research whether a test or procedure qualifies for the program, you could earn from \$125.00 to \$500.00, and in the process save you, your district and/or the MEUHP money. Please take a moment to review the MEUHP Cost Saver information later in this newsletter.

Starting January 1, 2021, **MDLIVE** will be the only virtual care vendor for Cigna customers, along with virtual care offered by in-network providers. *Cigna's virtual care* services vendor relationship with Amwell will be phased out by December 31, 2020. If you have not used **MDLIVE** before now would be a good time to go online and set up an account so that when you need to have a virtual visit with a provider you will only need to sign in and schedule an appointment. ## **Update on COVID-19 Testing & Treatment**



MEUHP is following Cigna's guidelines and extending COVID-19 protections for members through

December 31, 2020 for treatment and January 21, 2021 for testing.

FDA-approved COVID-19 testing and testingrelated services including the office visit, whether in person or virtual through January 21, 2021. The out-of-pocket costs for COVID-19 treatment-related visits at all sites of care, virtual or in person, and for both in- and out-ofnetwork providers will also continue to be waived through December 31, 2020.

It's important to understand diagnostic tests are covered for individuals with symptoms of a COVID-19 infection or who had exposure to someone with a suspected or confirmed COVID-19 infection, as well as for individuals before an elective hospital admission or procedure. Non-diagnostic and antibody tests are not covered by Cigna's standard coverage but may be covered as required by state law.

#### At-Home COVID-19 Test Kit

If you are concerned that you may have COVID-19 you can now get an at-home COVID-19 test kit. These at-home specimen collection kits are FDA-approved and are available through Cigna. They will be covered by Cigna (cost share waived). You will need to complete an online screening to have the kit sent to you. Click this link on your myCigna.com home page to get started.

You will also need to provide your Cigna insurance information. LabCorp will then mail your specimen kit to you. You will collect your own specimen by following the detailed instructions and return the kit to LabCorp using the prepaid mailer. Results are available 1-3 days after sample is received at lab. Must be 18 or older.

## It is not too late to get a Flu Shot

Peak flu season is December through February so for everyone 6 months and older it's not too late to get a flu shot. According to the CDC it is possible have the flu, as well as other respiratory illnesses, and COVID-19 at the same time so this year it may be more important than ever to consider getting your annual flu shot.

You can get your flu shot at In-Network Pharmacies or through your doctor. Visit myCigna.com for a link to Flu Vaccine locations.



## Let Us Help You Save Money and Earn an Incentive

MEUHP recognizes that the cost of health care varies based on location and provider so the **MEUHP Cost Saver Program** was created to help members save money and earn incentives in the process.

Cost Saver is a *voluntary* program that members contact when a non-emergency test or procedure is recommended by a health care provider. Cost Saver will research to find if that test or procedure is **eligible** for the program and if so,

then further research will be done to find facilities that will provide quality care and potentially save you money while also earning an incentive. Not all tests or procedure are eligible so please contact Cost Saver to find out if your test or procedure is eligible. Members are not required to use the recommendations made by Cost Saver but if used an incentive in the form of a gift card will be issued based on mileage from the members home to the qualifying facility.

Less than 50 miles: \$125 50-150 miles: \$250 Over 150 miles: \$500

Since July 1st when the Cost Saver
Program was implemented, we
have had inquires for all types of test
and procedures from X-rays, MRIs,
Colonoscopies and various types of
surgery. These referrals when used
will potentially save the member outof-pocket costs and earn the member
incentives as it did the member below.

Over the last two years we have established a schedule that allows me to spend a few hours in each of my districts each month, which makes it convenient for members to come see me with questions or thoughts that we can discuss.

## MotivateMe Incentives: Have You Taken Care of Yourself?

Many of us would answer "no" to that question and there is always a good reason, or so we think. We don't intentionally put our health or ourselves last, but there are many reasons that we let it slide, such as I'll wait until I have more time, I need to get caught up on this project, and the list of excuses goes on. But with the **Motivate Me** program there is no need for excuses. You can earn incentives and **take care of yourself** all at the same time, and who doesn't need a little extra cash as we are headed into the holidays!

It is very simple to get started in the **Motivate Me** program. All you need to do is visit **myCigna.com** and complete the first of two Start Up Goals which is an online Health Risk Assessment and you will earn \$25. This will take about 10 minutes of your time and will get you motivated to take that next step, which is a biometric screening with an incentive of \$50. Once you have completed both start-up goals the door will be opened to earn more incentives.

\* For <u>non-qualified expenses:</u> withdrawals taxed at individual's tax rate if over 65, plus 20% excise tax — if under age 65.


